Taiwan Studies Program

Overview, Guidelines, and Application Process

一、計畫目的

國家科學及技術委員會(以下簡稱本會)為深化國際學術界對臺灣議題之關注,增強海外臺灣研究之教學與研究能量,特推動「人文社會領域海外人才佈局策略計畫」,與海外頂尖大學合作,資助聘任專職推動臺灣研究之教授,藉以促進校內及校際臺灣研究之課程、學術出版及研究發展,並培養臺灣研究專業人才,建立海外臺灣研究網絡,深化臺灣研究在國際學術社群之影響力。

二、補助類別及執行期限

本計畫申請案之補助項目分為以下二類:

(一)、國科會臺灣研究新銳教授 NSTC Early Career Scholar (Assistant Professor) of Taiwan Studies:

學校可增設新任終身軌助理教授職缺(Tenure track assistant professor position),或延攬聘任本校或他校具學術潛力的專職教授(任教未滿六年),以協助整合與運用校內資源,推動跨領域的研究合作,工作內容包含(但不限於)開設臺灣研究相關課程、執行臺灣研究相關計畫、整合校內臺灣研究能量、促進與臺灣本地學校共同研究或學術出版、配合推動政府部會相關合作計畫等,並鼓勵非臺灣研究領域之專職教授擴展其研究與教學涵蓋臺灣相關主題,共同推動臺灣研究之跨領域發展。

本項可獲得補助年限為3年至5年、每年上限十二萬元美金或 等值之該國法定貨幣之金額補助,將依投入本計畫之工作比例 核定經費,總額上限為六十萬美金。最高聘任年限可依學校公 告之升等規定調整。若獲補助,學校將逐年收到補助經費。

(二)、國科會臺灣研究傑出教授 NSTC Chair (Professor) of Taiwan Studies:

學校可延攬具傑出學術成就之專職教授(須為校內副教授以上或相當職級),以領導校內臺灣研究之長遠學術發展,串聯區域或國際學術合作管道、擴大研究社群影響力並深化國際交流與合作。工作內容包含(但不限於)籌設校內臺灣研究學位學程、籌設校內臺灣研究常設學術組織或提升目前校內臺灣研究單位的能量、凝聚臺灣研究學術社群、招募臺灣研究專任研究人員、規劃與臺灣本地學校的合作研究等,並鼓勵非臺灣研究領域之專職教授擴展其研究與教學涵蓋臺灣相關主題,共同推動臺灣研究之跨領域發展。

本項可獲得補助年限為3年至5年、每年上限十五萬元美金或等值之該國法定貨幣之金額補助,將依投入本計畫之工作比例核定經費,總額上限為七十五萬美金。若獲補助,學校將逐年收到補助經費。

三、申請資格與辦法

(一)、申請資格:

申請學校需為各國近三年 QS 千名內或人文社科領域排名五百名之內之大學,或是其他獲本計畫認定符合資格之研究機構。設有(但不侷限)漢學研究、東亞研究、政治、歷史、文化等臺灣人文及社會科學相關領域之大學尤佳。

(二)、申請程序與審核項目:

1. 申請案須由校院等級單位同意後提出申請,並檢附相關佐 證資料。 2. 於申請網站 https://exp.stpi.niar.org.tw/project/TPHS/login 註冊及登入後,依系統要求填列表格及上傳申請資料。申 請資料送出後,請來信聯繫確認(taiwan phs@niar.org.tw)。

3. 審核項目:

- (1) 國科會臺灣研究新銳教授:計畫書應敘明推薦聘任學者的臺灣研究教學能力、投入本計畫的工作時數比例、 計畫到期後續聘為終身職或其他長期合約之規劃,並 應設置一名計畫主持人負責統籌規劃與執行。
- (2) 國科會臺灣研究傑出教授:計畫書應敘明每年教學與 研究等推動工作項目、投入本計畫的工作時數比例, 並提出短、中、長期推動藍圖,以及校內共同參與人 員與分工。

四、申請時間

本計畫每年辦理一梯次申請作業,自即日起開放徵件,本(114) 年度至11月13日(四)截止申請,並於申請到案後3個月內通 知學校審查結果,必要時得予延長。

五、注意事項

- (一) 本計畫之申請案及補助項目須經本計畫跨領域學術審查委員 會審查通過後核定。合作案件成立後,由執行單位財團法人國 家實驗研究院(NIAR)代表與合作學校簽訂合約;雙方之權 利義務悉依合約中約定條款為準,合作案之工作項目、考核與 補助款撥付方式詳訂於合約。
- (二) 通過補助之申請案,執行期間如合作學校欲調整或變更執行內容,包含計畫延期及終止,必須立即通知計畫辦公室;必要時,本計畫可要求合作學校調整執行內容。
- (三) 執行本計畫的受補助學者如涉有違反學術倫理情事,合作學校 須立即通報本計畫執行單位;如已於校內學術審議委員會判定 違反學術倫理者,依情節輕重可能被要求返還已受領之補助款。
- (四) 於執行期間若因各項因素以致職位空缺,該校應於知情後提出 新的聘任人選,相關規定詳訂於合約。
- (五) 合作學校若與本計畫執行單位就執行內容無法達成共識時,將 被要求限期改善,必要時可能終止補助。
- (六)獲補助學校須於各年度結束時提交執行成果報告,經學術審查通過後,得續約並撥付下一年度合作款項。成果報告內容須包含執行實質成果及經費使用狀況(經費表需有合作學校會計單位核章)。
